Flax is a cool season forb that prefers to be planted early in the cool spring. It is most commonly known as an oilseed, but it is also a great species to include in cover crop. Flax is very good at communicating with mycorrhizal fungi that already exists in your soil. Boosting the soils Fungi activity not only helps this crop but also the ones in the future.
