SHOWY MILKWEED

As a home for monarch butterflies, this perennial forb attracts quite the crowd of pollinators. The petals of the Showy Milkweed are a deep purple, pink and yellow and the horns extend out beyond the hood of the flower. The Showy Milkweed is grown in gardens, meadows, and native landscaping.

Light Requirements	Full
Bloom Period	June-August
Bloom Color	Purple
Mature Height	4 feet
Soil Moisture	Medium to Dry
Seeding Rate	15-20 lbs/acre
Package	1 lb, 5 lb
Planting Instructions	Site preparation is vital for allowing your seed to make clean contact with the soil, allowing for successful and uniform germination. Start with a clean, firm, weed-free seedbed to allow for uniform seed placement and an increased chance for faster establishment.
