SIDEOATS GRAMA

Sideoats Grama is used in erosion control and livestock and wildlife forage production. This range grass species grows in sandy to clay textured soils while being relatively drought tolerant. Side-Oat Grama will reach a height of 3' when mature and can be found in forests, rocky slopes, and other woodlands in much of U.S. and Canada.

VARIETIES

- Butte
 - Butte offers, high fire tolerance, slightly higher salinity tolerance, mid-summer bloom, high seedling vigor, and slow vegetative spread rate when compared to side-oat grama.
- El Reno
 - El Reno is a mid-summer bloom compared to a mid-spring bloom. El Reno also presents high seed abundance and high seedling vigor.
